Dear Guidance/College Counselor:

The Linly Heflin Scholarship is a scholarship that grants four-year scholarships in the amount of \$4,000 per year to a limited number of **Alabama women** who have both significant economic need and sound academic records. Please encourage your most outstanding senior women to apply. The Scholarship Committee reviews and chooses those who most meet the qualifications and granted an interview in 2017. Enclosed you will find the scholarship policies while other information and applications can be downloaded at www.linlyheflin.org.

Please note in our policies certain requirements that must be met:

1. Scholarships are restricted to four-year, Alabama, SACS accredited, colleges.
- 2. The minimum requirement for the ACT score is 23.**
3. Alabama resident and U.S. citizen
4. Financial need
5. Academic proficiency

The completed application form and supporting documents, **including 2016 fall transcripts**, must be mailed to our office and **postmarked by January 9, 2017. No applications will be accepted after the postmark deadline.** Please stress to the students that applications must include all supporting documents and be signed by a parent or guardian in order to be considered complete and eligible for review. The applications should include a current e-mail address and cell phone number for the applicant. For those applicants who are selected to receive a Linly Heflin Scholarship, our scholarship support continues for four years unless the recipient becomes unqualified by not meeting the obligations listed in the scholarship policies.
